


#### HAPPY BIRTHDAY PASTOR CLEAVE



## Pneumococcal Pneumonia

Hi dear friends and fellow Christians, How are you all ?

I wanted this month to share some info on Pneumococcal Pneumonia. This illness can come on quickly and be extremely serious warranting immediate care by a doctor. This is not a cold or the flu. It is an infectious and bacterial lung disease. It can spread thru coughing or close contact.

Symptoms may hit quickly and without warning. It may last for weeks and put you in the hospital and even be life threatening.

A vaccination may protect you. The CDC recommends a vaccine for those older than 18 who have asthma, diabetes, or chronic heart disease. It is also recommended for those of us who are 65 or older even if we consider ourselves healthy.

Symptoms of pneumococcal pneumonia may include:

- 1) high fever up to 105
- 2) excessive sweating
  - 3) shaking chills
  - 4) chest pain
  - 5) difficulty breathing
- 6) cough with phlegm that persists or gets worse
- If symptoms described above happen to you please consult your doctor immediately.



#### **WORSHIP ASSISTANT HELPERS NEEDED**


